MESSAGE FROM THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR



It has been an extraordinary year for the United Way of Beaver County (UWBC)! I am thrilled that you joined us this evening to celebrate the results of our 2023/2024 Annual Campaign. Tonight, we honor our vibrant community and the individuals who contribute to making it a remarkable place to live and work.

First, I extend my heartfelt thanks to our Member Agencies and every non-profit organization in Beaver County. Your dedicated staff work tirelessly to provide essential services to those in need, and it is greatly appreciated.

Secondly, I express my profound gratitude to every individual, every employee who participates in a workplace campaign, and every corporation that donates to the UWBC. Without your support, we could not fund the critical programs that serve our community. You help to build the capacity needed for our county to thrive and grow, making it an even better place for all.

Last year, I introduced you to ALICE (**A**sset **L**imited, **I**ncome **C**onstrained, **E**mployed) and I shared my vision of raising enough funds to establish The ALICE Fund, aimed at awarding mini-grants to agencies supporting ALICE and those in poverty. I am delighted to announce that in March, we awarded a total of \$70,000 in mini-grants to 12 organizations, with more to come. The significance of The ALICE Fund is even more pronounced now, as the percentage of ALICE and impoverished households has increased from 38% to 39% in just one year - an increase of 795 households in one year! This is a trend that we must work together to reverse.

There are many to thank for their generous contributions, but I must highlight a few who were instrumental in making The ALICE Fund possible: Shell Polymers Monaca, the Edwin D. Hill Charitable Trust, the NiSource Foundation, Eaton Corporation, Heritage Valley Health System Have a Heart Program, the Beaver County Board of Commissioners, the Housing Authority of the County of Beaver, Lincoln Learning Solutions, and the UWBC Board of Directors. We also recently received a grant that brings the total raised for The ALICE Fund to over \$300,000 in just one year! This incredible amount will help sustain the Fund for several years, allowing us to continue supporting ALICE families and identifying ways to better serve them.

My goal is to ensure that the UWBC remains focused and well-positioned to help our Member Agencies and others serving ALICE and the impoverished well into the future. This evening's 2023-2024 Annual Campaign result marks not the end, but the continuation of our journey into the future. I hope you will continue to walk alongside us as we move forward together - please follow us on Facebook, Instagram, and LinkedIn for current happenings and updates.

2023-2024 ALICE FUND MINI-GRANT AWARDEES

ALICE is an acronym for **A**sset **L**imited, **I**ncome **C**onstrained, **E**mployed. ALICE represents an **astounding 28% of the 39% of Beaver County households** that live at or below the ALICE threshold. This means that although they are working, they cannot afford even the essentials that most of us take for granted, but earn too much to qualify for assistance.

Although the 17 Member Agencies currently funded by the United Way of Beaver County provide services to ALICE households, there are many additional non-profit organizations in the county that serve ALICE and those in poverty, but who do not annually receive United Way funding. We have created The ALICE Fund Mini Grants to support charities in Beaver County who serve this vulnerable population.

We are so proud to announce that we have awarded a total of \$70,000 to the following local non-profits in 2024!



OUR MISSION

The United Way of Beaver County (UWBC) is a centralized, non-profit fundraising organization allocating resources, primarily through it's Member Agencies which provide for the human needs of the community.

We currently fund 17 Member Agencies through allocations from our Annual Campaign. We also provide funding to more than 50 other non-profit organizations through designated gifts from our donors.

\$ In 2023, we gave \$611,785 to our Member Agencies and local non-profits.

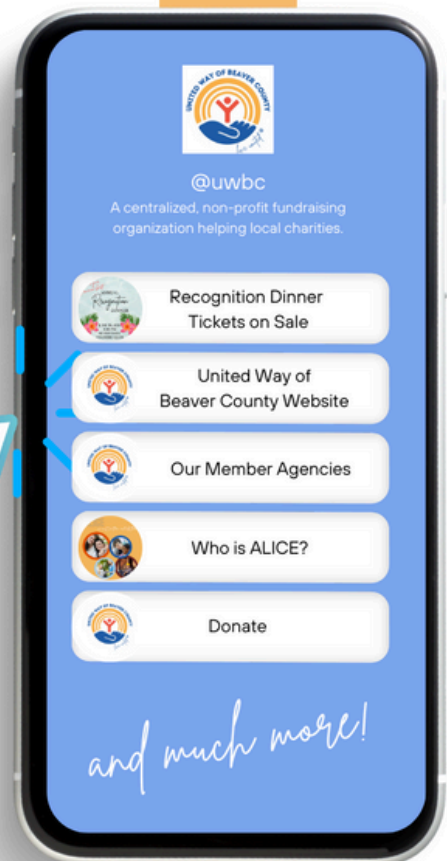

PA 211 is a vital part of the United Way of Beaver County's efforts to build stronger communities and fight for the health, education, and financial stability of every person in every community.

In 2023, PA 211 answered more than 385,000 calls, texts, and chats. People connected to resources on the 211 website over 903,000 times. Specifically in Beaver County, there was a total of 1,498 contacts by people in need of services.

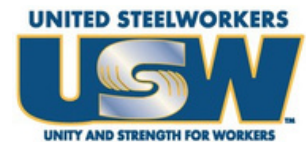

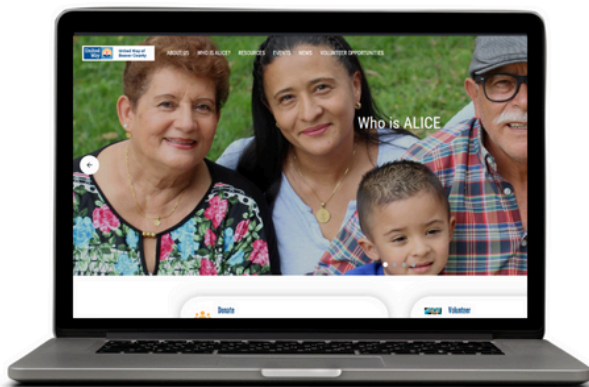
